

Environmental Policy

Jangro believe that businesses are responsible for operating in a sustainable manner and acknowledge that our day-to-day operations, including many of the products we supply impact the environment in a number of ways. It is the policy of all companies within the Jangro Organisation to minimise the potentially harmful effects of such activities wherever possible. Jangro maintains systems in place to meet the requirements of ISO 14001:2015 and Planet Mark Certification in pursuit of continually identifying and seeking solutions to environmental performance.

As part of our commitment to promote a positive and caring contribution to the protection of the environment, we have developed a comprehensive policy statement which enables us to set targets whereby our efforts towards sustainable environmental improvements can be measured, monitored and improved on a regular basis. Adhering to environmental regulations, laws and codes of practice will be regarded as setting the minimum standards of environmental performance.

The Jangro Board of Directors, supported by our Sustainability and Innovation Committee has specific responsibility for policy development, coordination, and evaluation of performance. Jangro is committed to sustainable practice and looking to improve current environmental issues.

The Jangro Organisation will:

1. Maintain a management system designed to meet the requirements is ISO 14001:2015, in pursuit of its objectives to identify and control environmental impact of activities, products and services.
2. Monitor progress and performance, and where appropriate, exceed the requirements of all relevant legislation. Where no regulations exist, the Jangro Organisation will set its own exacting standards.
3. Under the ISO 20400:2017 Sustainable Procurement guidance, work with a network of reputable suppliers who ensure their manufacturing operations are environmentally considerate and who are committed to environmental improvements.
4. Work with partner suppliers to ensure that products they supply for Jangro Ltd have been carefully formulated to minimise their impact on the environment.
5. Consider the cradle to grave cycle of our products, by recycling materials (where possible), providing a returnable system to our customers, and reusing the raw materials once recycled (where possible).
6. Minimise waste in all operations and dispose of any waste through safe and responsible methods.

7. Assist customers with safe and correct practice when using our products, in an environmentally safe way.
8. Address carbon emissions by monitoring, measuring and reducing Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions through carbon reporting; focusing on Scope 1 (direct emissions), Scope 2 (indirect emissions from energy consumption) and Scope 3 (indirect emissions from other activities).
9. Use environmentally safe and sustainable energy sources to meets the needs of all business requirements.
10. Ensure all employees are trained and are aware of our environmental policy, environmental issues and how they can monitor and reduce their environmental impact.
