DELIVERY			
Packaged in 10g soluble sachets	Risk of spillage if the sachet is dropped.	Trained employees should handle only 1 single sachet at any given time. Never open or tear sachets.	Transfer container to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave sachets in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Containers must be stored upright in a dry storage area. Product must be kept stored in its original container.	Minimal risk of spillage if used as per the manufacturer's instructions. Keep out of reach of children	Keep sachets in a secure storage area. Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel. Keep container dry.	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy. Make regular checks to ensure sachets are not split or damaged
USAGE			
A professional-use air freshener that comes in dissolvable sachets. Each sachet makes 500 ml of ready-to-use spray. Put one sachet into a Florasol™ spray bottle. Half-fill the bottle with warm water . Reattach the spray head and shake well until the sachet dissolves. Top up the bottle with cold water . Spray into the air, avoiding areas with fresh food.	Risk of eye contact. Risk of skin contact. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of spillage onto floor and into drainage system. In risk of fire on heating, irritating fumes may be produced.	Handle the sachets with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Brush up any spillages immediately. Ensure that the container is returned to the store when not in use. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: • Protective Gloves refer to EN374 • Safety Goggles refer to EN166 Face protection if splashing is possible When mixing solutions, ensure that operatives add product to water. Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel.
DISPOSAL			
Dispose of empty packaging and unused product according to local regulations.	Small risk of skin or eye contact. . Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of contamination with other substances.	Do not store any other material in the empty container. Ensure that the container is exhausted before disposal. Ensure that the product is not disposed of via a rainwater sewer (ie drain outside the building).	Ensure that all operatives always wear Personal Protective Equipment during disposal. Ensure that all operatives are aware of the First Aid equipment.
