PROCESS STAGE	POTENTIAL RISK	CONTROL MEASURES	ACTION REQUIRED
DELIVERY			
Packaged in 750 ml trigger spray bottles. Product is supplied ready to use.	Risk of spillage if the container is dropped.	Ensure that the trigger spray is secured at all times.	Transfer bottles to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave bottles in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Store product securely in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Product must be kept stored in its original container.	Minimal risk of spillage if bottles firmly in place.	Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel. Keep the store well ventilated. Store away from oxidizing agents and strong acids. Clear up spills immediately.	Store containers so their labels face forward. Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that bottles are not split or blown/damaged.
USAGE			
For spray sanitising. Remove any loose soil from surface to be cleaned. Spray directly on the surface. Allow 5 minute contact time. Follow PUG via the QR code.	Risk of eye contact. Risk of skin contact. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation.	Handle the spray with care. Ensure that the bottle is returned to the store when not in use. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use. Ensure that all spillages are wiped up immediately.	PPE required in normal use. Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel.
DISPOSAL			
Dispose of in accordance with relevant local regulations. Consign empty containers to normal waste.	Risk of eye or skin contact.	Wash out the container using plenty of water. Do not store any other material in the empty container. Ensure that the product is exhausted before disposal.	Personal Protective Equipment is not required during disposal.
