DELIVERY			
Packaged in 12 x100ml aerosol canisters in a cardboard carton. Delivered in single containers if required.	Risk of puncture if the canister is dropped. Risk of injury to user if dropped.	Trained employees should handle only single containers at any given time. Take care not to drop the containers. Ensure that the cap is always secure.	Transfer container to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave containers in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Containers must be stored upright in a cool, well ventilated, dry storage area. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame.	Minimal risk of spillage if caps are firmly in place. Caps are not child proof. Extremely Flammable	Keep containers in secure storage areas. Avoid heat, flames and other sources of ignition. Avoid contact with the following materials: Strong oxidising agents. Strong alkalis. Strong mineral acids. Keep at temperature not exceeding 50°C. Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel.	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy. Make regular checks to ensure containers are not corroded.
USAGE			
Ensure that all electronic equipment is switched OFF and all plug sockets are in the OFF position. Do not eat ,drink or smoke in a freshly sanitised room. Do not use when humans or animals are in the area. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use.	Risk of eye contact. Risk of skin contact. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of spillage onto floor and into drainage system.	Handle the canisters with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Ensure that the canister is returned to the store when not in use. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: • Protective Gloves • Safety Goggles Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel.
DISPOSAL			
Empty canisters can be disposed of as normal waste. Recycle all containers wherever facilities are available.	Small risk of skin or eye contact. Risk of contamination with other substances.	Ensure that the containers are exhausted prior to disposal. To dispose of residual stock, empty product via spraying outside in an open space. Do not puncture or incinerate even when empty.	Ensure that all operatives always wear Personal Protective Equipment during disposal. Ensure that all operatives are aware of the First Aid equipment.
