DELIVERY			
Packaged in 400 ml aerosol canister. Product is supplied ready to use.	Risk of spillage if the container is dropped. Risk of injury to user if dropped.	Take care not to drop canister. Ensure that the cap is secured at all times.	Transfer canisters to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave bottles in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from all sources of heat including direct sunlight.	Highly flammable. Pressurised canister there is therefore a risk of explosion if involved in a fire or if punctured.	Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel. Keep the store cool and well ventilated. Keep away from sources of heat.	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy.
USAGE			
Product is sprayed directly onto iced surface.	Risk of eye contact. Risk of skin contact. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of fire if sprayed near source of heat, flame of other source of ignition.	Handle the product with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Ensure that the canister is returned to the store when not in use. Never spray near source of ignition. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: • Protective Gloves • Safety Goggles Ensure application area is well ventilated. Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities and personnel..
DISPOSAL			
Spent canisters can be consigned to normal waste. Residual stocks must be disposed of in line with Local Authority Guidelines.	Small risk of skin or eye contact. Risk of fire if subjected to heat.	Do not puncture or incinerate even when empty. Ensure that the product is exhausted before disposal.	Ensure that all operatives always wear Personal Protective Equipment during disposal. Ensure that all operatives are aware of the First Aid equipment.
