PROCESS STAGE	POTENTIAL RISK	CONTROL MEASURES	ACTION REQUIRED
DELIVERY			
Packaged in plastic tubs. Re-sealable lids. Containers incorporate handles for carriage. Product is supplied ready to use.	Risk of spillage if the container is dropped. Risk of injury to user if dropped.	Trained employees should handle only single containers at any given time. Take care not to drop the containers. Ensure that the cap is always secure.	Transfer container to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave containers in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Containers must be stored upright in a cool, well ventilated, dry storage area. Product must be kept stored in its original container.	Minimal risk of spillage if lids are firmly in place. Lids are not child proof.	Keep in original containers. Keep containers in secure storage areas. Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel.	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy. Make regular checks to ensure containers are not split or blown.
USAGE			
Place product block including wrapper into cistern tank. Replace cistern lid. Add new cistern block when colour fades.	Risk of eye contact/damage. Risk of skin contact/irritation. Risk of ingestion.	Handle the containers and blocks with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Ensure that the container is returned to the store when not in use. Always read the manufacturer's instructions prior to use. Do not allow product to build up in tract or drains; renew only when exhausted.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: • Protective overall • Safety goggles • Protective Gloves Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities
DISPOSAL			
Empty containers can be disposed of as normal waste. Residual stocks must be disposed of as hazardous waste and disposed of accordingly. Recycle all containers wherever facilities are available.	Small risk of skin or eye contact. Risk of contamination with other substances. Risk of ingestion.	Wash out the container using plenty of water. Do not store any other material in the empty container. Ensure that the container is exhausted before disposal. Ensure that the product is not disposed of via a rainwater sewer (ie drain outside the building).	Ensure that all operatives wear Personal Protective Equipment at all times during disposal. Ensure that all operatives are aware of the First Aid equipment.
